Registration for all programs will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. We do not take registrations over the telephone. Class size is limited to the first 15 children who apply.

Waiting Lists: Due to the overwhelming popularity of our early childhood programs, we do keep waiting lists when classes fill. If an opening becomes available, we will contact you by telephone and e-mail. Please make sure the registration form includes daytime, evening and cell phone contact numbers and your e-mail address.

Deadline for registration is 5 p.m. the Thursday before the week of scheduled classes. Many of our classes are extremely popular. When classes are full you will be notified immediately that your registration was not received in time to secure a spot for your child.

Payment: Full payment must accompany your registration form. The cost of each class includes one child and one adult and is \$3.00 for members and \$3.50 for non-members. Each additional child is \$2.00. We accept checks, Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover cards. Checks are made payable to the Jacksonville Zoo.

Frequently Asked Questions

I am new to the program. How do you screen your staff?

All staff educators are screened for excellence in children’s programming. All have had previous experience with children and have cleared nationwide, state and FBI Level 2 background checks as prescribed by the State of Florida’s Jessica Lunsford Act.

Where are the classes held?

Story Safari programs are held at the PepsiCo Foundation Education Campus located at the south end of the zoo’s main parking lot. You do not need to enter the zoo in order to enter the education campus.

Classes begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. In your confirmation materials, you will receive a map showing the location of the Education Campus.

CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICIES: Cancellations received 10 business days or more prior to your scheduled class will receive a full refund less a 10% administrative fee. Cancellations made 9 to 5 business days prior to the first day of a class will receive a 75% refund of fees. Cancellations received less than 5 business days before the event forfeit all fees paid. The Education Department reserves the right to cancel or combine classes when they do not meet the minimum requirement of 3 students to provide the program. Exceptions to the cancellation and refund policies will be made on a case by case basis and at the sole discretion of the Director of Education.
